TOWN OF MANNING

A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF MANNING TO AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTION
OF AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE TOWN OF MANNING AND OTHER
MUNICIPALITIES FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN INTER-MUNICIPAL
SERVICE AGENCY TO BE KNOWN AS THE MACKENZIE MUNICIPAL
SERVICES AGENCY

WHEREAS

The Municipal Government Act allows a municipality to enter into an agreement with other municipalities for the performance of any matter or thing judged to be of benefit to them, and

WHEREAS

The Municipal Government Act allows for the establishment of an inter-municipal service agency, and

WHEREAS

The Town of Manning considers it beneficial to enter into an agreement with certain other municipalities for the provision of planning, subdivision and regional/community economic development services.

NOW THEREFORE

The Council of the Town of Manning in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

1. The agreements for the provision of services through the establishment of an inter-municipal service agency to be known as the Mackenzie Municipal Services Agency, copies of which are attached hereto, are hereby ratified and approved; and the Mayor and the Municipal Administrator are hereby authorized to execute the said agreements for and on behalf of the Town of Manning.
2. This Bylaw shall come into full force and effect upon third and final reading.
