

## **Council Highlights**

### **April 27, 2016 Council Meeting**

- Council approved the revised operating budget with revenue of \$5,249,775 and expenditures of \$5,367,582.
- Council approved the revised capital budget of \$1,300,993 for buildings, machinery, equipment, and infrastructure.
- Council approved the Mayor's travel to Grande Prairie and Olds to attend both Mayors Caucus meetings in June 2016.
- Council defeated a motion to appoint the CAO to approve all councillor remuneration time sheets.
- Council approved the County request for the Town to forfeit utility charges on the new doctor's residence for a period of six months.
- Council approved to not increase the 2016 mill rate for residential.
- Council defeated a motion to increase the vacant non-residential mill rate from 13.0 mills to 13.5 mills.
- Council approved to not increase the 2016 mill rate for non-residential and vacant non-residential.
- Council proclaimed May 29<sup>th</sup>, to June 4<sup>th</sup>, 2016 as Victims and Survivors of Crime Week.
- Council approved to rescind Motion 1571 to authorize a reduction of taxes levied.
