



TOWN OF MANNING BEAUTIFICATION POLICY POLICY #2017-09

Beautification Policy

A policy to guide the Town of Manning, its residents and businesses, on ways and means to make the town visually appealing to both visitors and residents while installing a sense of community pride.

Purpose

The Town of Manning strives to keep the town aesthetically pleasing to both residents and visitors through a program implementing both beautification upgrades and maintenance of existing beautification methods.

Guidelines


- 1.1 Implementation of a "Beautification Committee" consisting of two members of Council, and up to three volunteer members of the community.
- 1.2 The planting of trees or shrubs on town properties where pleasing so long as the tree root systems are not interfering with the function of town underground infrastructure.
- 1.3 Existing trees and/or shrubs that are not interfering with underground infrastructure, shall be maintained by the town to ensure sightlines and overall curb appeal.
- 1.4 Trees that are dead, diseased or impeding underground infrastructure function, may be removed with approval of the beautification committee.
- 1.5 The Beautification Committee shall arrange the purchase, keeping in mind fiscal responsibility the flowers for the hanging baskets and barrels along Main Street, the welcome signs situated on the outskirts of the town and the flower bed at the Town office. The Committee shall pick the colours and flower of choice.
- 1.6 The beautification of parks and playgrounds by means of garbage receptacles to ensure litter is contained along with the installation of benches and picnic tables.
