BY-LAW 846-17

REPEAL OF LOCAL IMPROVEMENT CHARGE AND DEBENTURE

A By-law of the Town of Manning, in the Province of Alberta for the repealing of a Local Improvement Charge Bylaw # 836/16 (Robert Plante) and Debenture Bylaw # 799/12 and Bylaw # 800/12 (Paving 5th Street NE);

WHEREAS Section 63(1) of the Municipal Government Act, a Council may by bylaw authorize the revision of all or any of the bylaws of the municipality;

AND WHEREAS Section 63(2)(b) of the Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, Chapter M-26, as amended authorizes a Council to establish by bylaw for the repeal of a bylaw or a provision of a bylaw that is inoperative, obsolete, expired, spent or otherwise ineffective;

NOW THEREFORE PURSUANT to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26, the Council of the Town of Manning, Alberta, in regular session duly assembled, enacts as follows:

SECTION 1 – SHORT TITLE

This By-law may be cited as the “Repeal of Local Improvement Charge and Debenture.”

SECTION 2 – BYLAWS EXPIRED

- 2.1 Local Improvement – Bylaw # 837-16 amount has been repaid in full.
- 2.2 Debenture – Bylaw #799-12 and Bylaw 800-12 paving 5th Street NE repaid.

SECTION 3 – EFFECTIVE DATE

- 3.1 This By-law shall come into effect the date upon third and final reading.

READ A FIRST TIME this 27th day of September, 2017


READ A SECOND TIME this 27th day of September, 2017
