

A BY-LAW OF THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MANNING, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE NORTH PEACE GAS CO-OP.

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient and proper pursuant to Section 281 of the Municipal Government Act, the Council of the Town of Manning, in the Province of Alberta hereby applies to the Public Utilities Board for approval of a natural gas supply contract (renewal) between the Town of Manning and the North Peace Gas Co-op for a period not in excess of *Ten (10)* years from the *1st* day of *June* 1983.

The Council hereby declares:

- (a) That the natural gas supply contract (renewal) is necessary and proper for the public convenience and properly conserves the public interests.
- (b) That the scheme of North Peace Gas Co-op for the supply of natural gas under the provisions of the natural gas supply contract (renewal) is reasonable and sufficient having regard to the general circumstances.
- (c) That having regard to the availability of any other source of supply of natural gas in the area in which the municipality is situate and to any other circumstances, the entering into the natural gas supply contract (renewal) is to the general benefit of the area directly or indirectly affected thereby.

Bylaw No. 531 is hereby rescinded.
