BY-LAW 829 - 15

COUNCIL PROCEDURE BYLAW AMENDMENT

A By-law of the Town of Manning, in the Province of Alberta for the purpose of amending the Town of Manning Council Procedure Bylaw No. 808-13 pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M26, and Revised Statutes of Alberta 2006.

WHEREAS Council of the Town of Manning, in the Province of Alberta, has adopted the Town of Manning Council Procedure Bylaw No. 808-13;

AND WHEREAS Council of the Town of Manning, in the Province of Alberta, deems it necessary to amend the Town of Manning Council Procedure Bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE PURSUANT to provisions of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26, the Town of Manning Council, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

SEVERABILITY

If any provision of this by-law is declared invalid because of any word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this by-law or any documents which form part of this by-law or an application thereof to any person or circumstance is declared invalid, the remaining provisions shall not be affected thereby, but shall remain in force.

SECTION 1 – SHORT TITLE

This By-law may be cited as the “Council Procedure Bylaw Amendment”.

SECTION 2 – MEETINGS, AGENDA AND ORDER OF BUSINESS

All references to the Mayor shall be replaced with Deputy Mayor in section 5.2.b (ix), and

Section 5.5.b The Mayor shall not be deemed to be a *defacto* member of all Committees of Council and all bodies to which Council has the right to appoint members under the Act, Section 154(2)


SECTION – 3 EFFECTIVE DATE
