BY-LAW 657/95 TOWN OF MANNING

A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF MANNING TO ESTABLISH SUBDIVISION AUTHORITY AND AUTHORIZE THE DELEGATION OF SUBDIVISION AUTHORITY FOR THE TOWN OF MANNING TO THE MACKENZIE MUNICIPAL SERVICES AGENCY

WHEREAS

Section 623 of the Municipal Government Act requires a council to provide for a subdivision authority to exercise subdivision powers and duties on behalf of the municipality, and

WHEREAS

Section 625 of the Municipal Government Act allows a municipality to delegate its subdivision authority powers, duties and functions to an inter-municipal service agency, and

WHEREAS

The Town of Manning Council considers it beneficial to delegate the subdivision authority.

NOW THEREFORE

The Council of the Town of Manning, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. That the subdivision authority, including accepting, processing, decisions and endorsement of applications for subdivision, be delegated to the Mackenzie Municipal Services Agency.
- 2. This Bylaw shall come into effect on the date of the third and final reading.
