

BY-LAW 645/93
TOWN OF MANNING

A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF MANNING FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THAT
CONTRACTORS/EXCAVATORS REQUEST AND OBTAIN A DIGGING PERMIT
FROM THE TOWN OF MANNING PRIOR TO DIGGING WITHIN TOWN LIMITS

WHEREAS The Council of the Town of Manning deems it desirable and necessary to establish a digging permit system for safety considerations; and

WHEREAS The Council of the Town of Manning sees merit in having a person obtain a digging permit prior to anyone digging on property in the Town of Manning;

NOW THEREFORE The Council of the Town of Manning, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

1. The addition of the following sub-section to the Town of Manning land Use By-law #497:

6.4.0 DIGGING PERMITS

6.4.1 Notwithstanding any other provision in this By-law, a person will require a "digging permit" from the Town prior to excavation works.

6.4.2 There will be no fee charged when applying for a "digging permit".

6.4.3 That any contractor or excavator who plans on digging in or on property within the Town of Manning adhere to the following procedures before digging:

a) Before digging, the contractor or excavator shall call the Alberta 1st Call Location Service (1-800-242-3447) requesting site locations. The contractor/excavator shall provide Alberta 1st Call with the following information: Company name, site location, excavation time and place and the type of excavation. Alberta 1st Call requests that two working days notice be allowed. Alberta 1st Call provides notification to all Alberta 1st Call members directly affected by the planned excavation.

b) On receipt of the Alberta One Call notification, the Town of Manning (usually the Gas Utilities Foreman) and by request of the excavator/contractor, will proceed to locate and mark all lines; then issue a digging permit. The Town of Manning requests 24 hours notice be allowed. Once the contractor/excavator has been issued the digging permit, he may proceed to dig. The excavator/contractor must follow the requirements as stated on the issued digging permits.

6.4.4 That any person who commits a breach of By-law 645/93 shall be liable to a fine not exceeding TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00) exclusive of costs. Imprisonment in default of payment of this fine shall not be imposed under any circumstances.

2. That this by-law shall take effect on the date of its final passing.
