

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF MANNING, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE TOWN OF GRIMSHAW, VILLAGE OF BERWYN, AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 22 TO PROVIDE FOR THE JOINT ESTABLISHMENT AND OPERATION OF A REGIONAL SOLID WASTE SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, Section 113 of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 R.S.A., 1980 and amendments thereto provides that:

(1) a Council may pass a bylaw authorizing the making of an agreement with the council of any other municipality for the joint construction, ownership, maintenance, operation or use of a public work or building or for the performance of any other matter or thing considered by all the Councils concerned to be a benefit to their respective municipalities, and may enter into an agreement as to the joint control and management of any thing that concerns their respective municipalities, and may enter into an agreement as to the joint control and management of any thing that concerns their respective municipalities, and (2) the Council may in the by-law appoint one or more of its members to be members of joint committee with members appointed by the Councils of other municipalities and may delegate to such joint committee power to construct, maintain, control and manage such undertaking, including the power to disburse the proceeds of debentures or other funds used for the purpose of such undertaking; and

WHEREAS, in the interests of minimizing potential damage to the environment from improper refusedisposal the participating local authorities wish to establish a regional solid waste system to serve all participating municipalities.

NOW THEREFORE, by virtue of the powers vested in it the Council of the Town of Manning, in the Province of Alberta hereby enacts as follows:

- (1) That the Town of Manning enter into an agreement with the Town of Grimshaw, Village of Berwyn, and Improvement District No. 22 for the construction, ownership, maintenance, operation and use of a regional solid waste system.
- (2) That the Mayor and Town Manager of the Town of Manning be authorized to sign the aforementioned agreement on behalf of the Town of Manning and affix the Town seal thereto.
- (3) That two (2) members of the Town Council as may be designated by resolution of the said Council, from time to time, be authorized to represent the Town on a regional solid waste management authority responsible for the construction, maintenance, control and management of the solid waste system.
- (4) That the regional solid waste management authority shall have the power to disburse the proceeds of debentures or other funds used for the purpose of the regional solid waste system.
- (5) That the regional solid waste management authority may in each year requisition the Council of each participating municipality for the proportionate share of the cost of operating the regional solid waste management system and expend any sums so requisitioned for the control, management, upkeep and operational expenses of the regional solid waste management system.
- (6) That the regional solid waste management authority shall in each year furnish the Council of each participating municipality with an audited statement of its receipts and payments for the preceding year and shall also supply each such Council with any information regarding its management and operation that is considered necessary.

(7) This Bylaw shall take effect on date of final passing thereof.
