

BY-LAW NO. 602

A BY-LAW OF THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MANNING, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, FOR THE REGULATING AND CONTROLLING OF STRAY CATS.

WHEREAS Section 164 of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1980, and amendments thereto, provides for the passing of bylaws to regulate and control cats; and

WHEREAS the council of the Town of Manning considers it desirable to control stray cats within the municipality;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Manning, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

- (a) "Stray" means a cat which appears to be homeless.
- (b) A town employee may capture any cat which he believes on reasonable and probable grounds, to be a stray and cause such cat to be impounded.
- (c) Any cat which has been delivered to a pound as a result of a capture pursuant to the provisions of this bylaw may be destroyed if unclaimed for a period of 48 hours following its delivery.

This bylaw shall come into effect on the date of its final passing.

READ a third time and finally passed this 23 day of AUGUST, 1989.
