BY-LAW 848-17

REPEAL OF BY-LAW 825-15; MUNICIPAL PLANNING COMMISSION & BY-LAW 828-15 LAND USE BYLAW AMENDMENT

A By-law of the Town of Manning, in the Province of Alberta for the repealing of Municipal Planning Commission;

WHEREAS Section 63(1) of the Municipal Government Act, a Council may by bylaw authorize the revision of all or any of the bylaws of the municipality;

AND WHEREAS Section 63(2)(b) of the Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, Chapter M-26, as amended authorizes a Council to establish by bylaw for the repeal of a bylaw or a provision of a bylaw that is inoperative, obsolete, expired, spent or otherwise ineffective;

NOW THEREFORE PURSUANT to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26, the Council of the Town of Manning, Alberta, in regular session duly assembled, enacts as follows:

SEVERABILITY

If any provision of this by-law is declared invalid because of any word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this by-law or any documents which form part of this by-law or an application thereof to any person or circumstance is declared invalid, the remaining provisions shall not be affected thereby, but shall remain in force.

SECTION 1 – SHORT TITLE

This By-law may be cited as the “Repeal of Municipal Planning Commission and Amendments.”

SECTION 2 – EFFECTIVE DATE

3.1 This By-law shall come into effect the date upon third and final reading.
