CHRIS GRAW MANNING PLAYGROUND SOCIETY A conference call with Chris Graw from the Manning Playground Society was conducted. Chris reviewed the letter sent from Playworks in regards to the Splash park repairs. The scope of work from Playworks was discussed and Council assured Chris that they would come to a decision later in the meeting.

CURTIS GRAY NOTIKEWAN RIVER Curtis Gray, informed Council that Fire Chief Brolly suggested that no pets, or children enter the river. Councillor Rycroft reminded Mr. Gray that Alberta Environment had hired a 3rd Party to look into this matter, and kindly asked if he could wait for their report.

CAO REPORT

Chief Administrative Officer, Egyedy informed Council that Tri-Line Contracting Services from Peace River was contacted in regards to the bridge lift station sewage leak. The station was shut down on September 6, 2017 due to a pipe separation in the force-main. Egyedy is getting quotes on the repairs; however, there are few companies that work with clay pipes and sewage.

Egyedy will investigate the possible cost of repairs versus the rebuilding of the lift station and forcemain. There are grants available for waste water projects and administration will make application.

Egyedy reported to Council that the Town of Manning has successfully switched over to Gas Alberta from North Peace Gas Co-op Ltd. The Gas Alberta gas cost rate for August was \$2.52/GJ whereas North Peace Gas was \$3.07/GJ. The October gas rate will be \$1.82/GJ.
