SUBDIVISION AND DEVELOPMENT APPEAL BOARD AMENDMENT

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF MANNING, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING THE TOWN OF MANNING SUBDIVISION AND DEVELOPMENT APPEAL BOARD BYLAW No. 852/18.

WHEREAS The Council of the Town of Manning, in the Province of Alberta, has adopted the Town of Manning Subdivision and Development Appeal Board Bylaw No. 852/18 and;

WHEREAS Pursuant to the Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, Chapter M-26, Council may amend a Subdivision and Development Appeal Board Bylaw, and;

WHEREAS Council of the Town of Manning, in the Province of Alberta, deems it necessary to amend the Town of Manning Subdivision and Development Appeal Board Bylaw, and;

WHEREAS The said amendment will amend the Board to consist of a maximum of six (6) members, comprising one (1) member of Council and five (5) members-at-large.

NOW THEREFORE Pursuant to provisions of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26, the Town of Manning Council, duly assembled, hereby enact as follows:

- 1. That Section III Subsection 1 will state the Board shall consist of a maximum of six (6) members, comprising one (1) member of Council and five (5) members-at-large.

SEVERABILITY

- 1. If any portion of this Bylaw is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, then the invalid portion shall be severed.


EFFECTIVE DATE
