SUBDIVISION AND DEVELOPMENT APPEAL BOARD AMENDMENT

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF MANNING IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING THE TOWN OF MANNING SUBDIVISION AND DEVELOPMENT APPEAL BOARD BYLAW No. 852/18.

WHEREAS The Council of the Town of Manning, in the Province of Alberta, has adopted the Town of Manning Subdivision and Development Appeal Board Bylaw No. 852 -18, as amended, and;

WHEREAS Council of the Town of Manning, in the Province of Alberta, deems it necessary to amend the Town of Manning Subdivision and Development Appeal Board Bylaw No. 852/18, and;

WHEREAS The said amendment will change the eligibility requirements and appointment of Board members and the Clerk of the Subdivision and Development Appeal Board;

NOW THEREFORE Pursuant to the Province of Alberta *Municipal Government Act*, the Town of Manning Council, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

1. Replace Section III - Administration subsection 1 and 2 with the following:
 1. The Board shall consist of a maximum of six (6) members, only one of whom may be a member of Council.
 2. Appointment of the members of the Board shall be made by resolution of Council annually at their organizational meeting, or as needed to provide for the membership of Board.
2. Remove Section III - Administration subsection 9.
3. Replace Section IV - Clerk subsection 1 with the following:
 1. Council shall appoint a Clerk in compliance with the requirement of Section 627.1 of the Act to perform the duties set out below.

SEVERABILITY

4. If any portion of this Bylaw is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, then the invalid portion shall be severed.

EFFECTIVE DATE


5. That this Bylaw shall come into effect the date upon third and final reading.

READ A FIRST TIME this 12th day of June, 2019

READ A SECOND TIME this 12th day of June, 2019
