SNOW REMOVAL AND ICE CONTROL

POLICY #2017-07

Snow Removal and Ice Control Policy

All Public Works employees will adhere to the following priority guidelines when snow or ice conditions exist on streets in the Town of Manning.

Purpose

Town employees will strive to maintain good driving conditions on all main arteries within seven (7) hours of a major snowfall of 12 centimetres or greater. The Public Works Leadhand will consult with the Chief Administrative Officer to determine if snow blown removal is required.

Guidelines

- 1.1 Snow removal in the downtown/commercial core will commence in the evening after 10:00pm until 8:00am in the morning. Residential street snow clearing will be done during daylight hours.
- 1.2 Priority for snow clearing is as follows:
 - 1.2.1 Downtown/Commercial Areas;
 - (1) 6th Avenue NE to the Manning Fire Department
 - (2) 1st Avenue SW to the Del Aire Lodge
 - (3) 4th Avenue to the Rosary and 3rd Street SE to Elementary Schools
 - (4) 1st Street NE and 3rd Avenue NE to Paul Rowe School
 - (5) 1st Avenue SW
 - 1.2.2 Residential Areas;
 - (1) Alternating starts from NE, NW, SE, SW residential quadrants
 - (2) Gravel streets will be graded to the sides, no snow blowing
 - (3) Alleyways will not be graded unless required and residents notified
- 1.3 Downtown and Bridge sidewalks snow sweeping between 6:00am and 8:00am. Sanding and salting anytime as required.
- 1.4 Intersection sanding as required to ensure safe braking of vehicles.
