

Bylaw No. 801/2012
A Bylaw of the Town of Manning, in the Province of Alberta, for the Purpose of Amending Bylaw No. 680/1997, Being the Town of Manning Bylaw Authorizing the Operation of Off-Highway Vehicles within the Town of Manning

WHEREAS Pursuant to the Province of Alberta Municipal Government Act, a Council may amend a Bylaw; and

WHEREAS The Council of the Town of Manning deems it expedient to authorize and regulate the operation of "Off-Highway" vehicles and "All Terrain" vehicles within the Town of Manning;

NOW THEREFORE Pursuant to the authority granted under Section 18 (2)(b) of the Alberta Off-highway Vehicle Act, being Chapter 0-5 R.S.A. 2000 and amendments thereto, the Council of the Town of Manning hereby enacts as follows:

1. That "Off-highway Vehicles" and "All-terrain Vehicles" be permitted to only operate in alleys in order to proceed to or return from areas outside the Town limits; roadways may be used only to gain access to alleys by the shortest and most direct route, but at no time shall Main Street (Hwy 35), sidewalks or walking trails be used for this purpose;
2. No person shall operate an "Off-highway Vehicle" or "All-terrain Vehicle" within the corporate limits of the Town of Manning between the hours of 11:00p.m. and 7:00a.m.
3. Operators of "Off-highway Vehicles" and "All-terrain Vehicles" shall travel single file only on the extreme right-hand side of roadways or alleys and at a speed no greater than 15 km per hour;
4. Operators of "Off-highway Vehicles" and "All-terrain Vehicles" shall yield to right-of-way at all times to other motor vehicles;
5. A person who is guilty of a first offense under this by-law shall be liable to a fine of not more than \$50.00;
6. A person who is guilty of a second or subsequent offense under this bylaw shall be liable to a fine of not more than \$100.00.

By-law 680 is hereby repealed.


Read a second time this 8th day of August 2012.
